HEBREW 71.7. Transliteration: rûa' (roo-ah') a primitive root; to mar (especially by breaking); figurative

to split the ears (with sound), i.e. shout (for alarm or joy) :- blow an alarm, cry (alarm,

aloud, out), destroy, make a joyful noise, smart, shout (for joy), sound an alarm, triumph.

the STONE HELPER (1 Samuel 4:1-9, 7:1-12)
```

the hard, solid, nonmetallic mineral matter of which rock is composed

the STORM CALMER (Matthew 14:30-32, Mark 4:35-39)

an atmospheric disturbance characterized by a strong wind, usually accompanied by precipitation, and often thunder and lightening

the STAIN LIFTER (the STAIN is not the SPOT, but what CAUSES the SPOT)

To spoil the appearance of by patches, streaks of color, or dirt; discolor
