# Monday

## **EVIDENCE #1: DISCERN DELAY**

DISCERN (WEB-to perceive or recognize; make out

clearly)

DELAY (WEB-to put off to a future time; postpone;

make late; slow up; detain)

PATIENCE (GK-hupomone [endurance])

(WEB-the will or ability to wait or endure

without complaint)

PERFECT (GK-teleios [complete, mature])

(WEB-complete in all respects; without defect

or omission; sound; flawless)

DELAY IS GOD'S WAY OF SAYING 'ITS NOT TIME YET'

### **DELAY IS A SIGNAL THAT**

- 1. someone (or something) must be **PREPARED**
- 2. someone (or something) must be **REPAIRED**
- 3. someone (or something) must be **DECLARED**

#### FOR MEDITATION

EVIDENCE #2: DO THE 'DO'

EVIDENCE (WEB-[that] which makes something else easy to see or perceive; [that which makes clear, obvious, plain, or apparent])

IF <u>GOD SAID IT</u> AND <u>YOU BELIEVE IT</u> THEN JUST DO IT!

## WHAT SHALL I 'DO'?

1. DO the **RIGHT** thing

For with what **judgment ye judge**, **ye shall be judged**: and with **what measure ye mete**, **it shall be measured to you again**. Matthew 7:2 [KJV]

2. DO the **REAL** thing

But let your communication be, Yea, yea; Nay, nay: Matthew 5:37 [KJV]

3. DO the **RESPONSIBLE** thing

But if any provide not for his own, and specially for those of his own house, he hath denied the faith, and is worse than an infidel. 1 Tim. 5:8 [KJV]

4. DO the **RADICAL** thing

If thine enemy be hungry, give him bread to eat; and if he be thirsty, give him water to drink: Prov 25:21 And unto him that smiteth thee on the one cheek offer also the other; and him that taketh away thy cloke forbid not to take thy coat also. Luke 6:29

5. DO the **ROYAL** thing

...I am your father and master, but where are the honor and respect I deserve? You have despised my name!"But you ask, 'How have we ever despised your name?' "You have despised my name by offering defiled sacrifices on my altar."Then you ask, 'How have we defiled the sacrifices?""You defile them by saying the altar of the Lord deserves no respect. When you give blind animals as sacrifices, isn't that wrong? And isn't it wrong to offer animals that are crippled and diseased? Try giving gifts like that to your governor, and see how pleased he is!" says the Lord Almighty. Mal1:6-8 [NLT]

#### EVIDENCE #3: **DEMONSTRATE DISCRETION**

DISCRETION

(WEB-the quality of being careful about what one says or does; prudence; the ability to keep silent or preserve confidences when necessary)

THE LORD SHALL FIGHT FOR YOU, AND YE SHALL HOLD YOUR PEACE (Ex 14:14)

## DISCRETION IS THE ABILITY TO SAY or DO

- the RIGHT THING (WHAT)
- the RIGHT WAY (HOW)
- in the RIGHT PLACE (WHERE)
- at the RIGHT TIME (WHEN)
