<u>NAME</u>	<u>MEANING</u>	<u>PRIMARY REFERENCE</u>
Adonai	Master, Owner - shown as "Lord" in Scripture	<i>Genesis 15:2 (KJV) And Abram said, Lord GOD, what wilt thou give me, seeing I go childless, and the steward of my house is this Eliezer of Damascus?</i>
El Shaddai	All sufficient, bountiful, suppling	<i>Genesis 17:1 (KJV) And when Abram was ninety years old and nine, the LORD appeared to Abram, and said unto him, I am the Almighty God; walk before me, and be thou perfect.</i>
El Olam	Everlasting GOD	<i>Genesis 21:33 (KJV) And Abraham planted a grove in Beersheba, and called there on the name of the LORD, the everlasting God.</i>
El Elyon	Most High GOD	<i>Genesis 14:18 (KJV) And Melchizedek king of Salem brought forth bread and wine: and he was the priest of the most high God.</i>
El Gibbor	Mighty GOD	<i>Isaiah 9:6 (KJV) For unto us a child is born, unto us a son is given: and the government shall be upon his shoulder: and his name shall be called Wonderful, Counsellor, The mighty God, The everlasting Father, The Prince of Peace.</i>
El Ro'i	The Seeing One	<i>Genesis 16:13 (KJV) And she called the name of the LORD that spake unto her, Thou God seest me: for she said, Have I also here looked after him that seeth me?</i>
El Rachuw'n	The Merciful (Compassionate) One	<i>Deuteronomy 4:31 (KJV) (For the LORD thy God is a merciful God;) he will not forsake thee, neither destroy thee, nor forget the covenant of thy fathers which he sware unto them.</i>
El Na'sa	The Forgiving One	<i>Psalms 99:8 (KJV) Thou answeredst them, O LORD our God: thou wast a God that forgavest them, though thou tookest vengeance of their inventions.</i>
El Hannun	The Gracious One	<i>Jonah 4:2 (KJV) And he prayed unto the LORD, and said, I pray thee, O LORD, was not this my saying, when I was yet in my country? Therefore I fled before unto Tarshish: for I knew that thou art a gracious God, and merciful, slow to anger, and of great kindness, and repentest thee of the evil.</i>
El Kanna	The Jealous One	<i>Exodus 34:14 (KJV) For thou shalt worship no other god: for the LORD, whose name is Jealous, is a jealous God:</i>
Jehovah	I (Je) Be (havah) - shown as "LORD" in Scripture	<i>Psalms 83:18 (KJV) That men may know that thou, whose name alone is JEHOVAH, art the most high over all the earth.</i>

Jehovah-jireh	The LORD our Provider	<i>Genesis 22:14 (KJV) 14 And Abraham called the name of that place Jehovahjireh: as it is said to this day, In the mount of the LORD it shall be seen.</i>
Jehovah-rapha	The LORD our Healer	<i>Exodus 15:26 (KJV) And said, If thou wilt diligently hearken to the voice of the LORD thy God, and wilt do that which is right in his sight, and wilt give ear to his commandments, and keep all his statutes, I will put none of these diseases upon thee, which I have brought upon the Egyptians: for I am the LORD that healeth thee.</i>
Jehovah-nissi	The LORD our Banner	<i>Exodus 17:15 (KJV) And Moses built an altar, and called the name of it Jehovahnissi:</i>
Jehovah-shalom	The LORD our Peace	<i>Judges 6:24 (KJV) Then Gideon built an altar there unto the LORD, and called it Jehovahshalom: unto this day it is yet in Ophrah of the Abiezrites.</i>
Jehovah-tsidkenu	The LORD our Righteousness	<i>Jeremiah 23:6 (KJV) In his days Judah shall be saved, and Israel shall dwell safely: and this is his name whereby he shall be called, THE LORD OUR RIGHTEOUSNESS.</i>
Jehovah-shammah	The LORD is there {present}	<i>Ezekiel 48:35 (KJV) It was round about eighteen thousand measures: and the name of the city from that day shall be, The LORD is there.</i>
Jehovah-ra'ah (rohi)	The LORD our Shepherd	<i>Psalms 23:1 (KJV) The LORD is my shepherd; I shall not want.</i>
Jehovah-saboath	The LORD of Hosts	<i>1 Samuel 1:3 (KJV) And this man went up out of his city yearly to worship and to sacrifice unto the LORD of hosts in Shiloh. And the two sons of Eli, Hophni and Phinehas, the priests of the LORD, were there.</i>
Jehovah-makkeh	The LORD who smiteth	<i>Ezekiel 7:9 (KJV) And mine eye shall not spare, neither will I have pity: I will recompense thee according to thy ways and thine abominations that are in the midst of thee; and ye shall know that I am the LORD that smiteth.</i>
Jehovah-hoseen(u)	The LORD our Maker	<i>Psalms 95:6 (KJV) O come, let us worship and bow down: let us kneel before the LORD our maker.</i>
Jehovah-M'Kaddesh	The LORD who Sanctifies	<i>Leviticus 20:8 (KJV) And ye shall keep my statutes, and do them: I am the LORD which sanctify you.</i>
